UGA LSAMP students conducting research must fulfill all program requirements outlined below in order to be considered in good standing and an active participant in the program. The requirements and expectations are listed below.

Requirements

- 1. Full-time undergraduate student (enrolled in at least 12 hours/semester) at the University of Georgia.
- 2. Maintain a (semester AND overall) GPA of 2.75 or higher
- 3. Pursuing a degree in a STEM discipline and be in good academic standing.
- 4. Attend 80% of LSAMP program meetings, workshops, and seminars during the semester.
- 5. Maintain open communication with the UGA LSAMP Campus Coordinator.
- 6. Complete and turn in any additional paperwork as needed as the semester progresses.
- 7. Continue making strides towards satisfactory academic progress and remain in good academic with the program.
- 8. Visit the Peach State LSAMP Office at least twice a semester (unless otherwise specified).
- 9. Make sure your file is current and up-to-date at the beginning of each semester.
- 10. Complete 10 hours of community service.
